Notes about the TCHS ‘At home Learning Plan’

- Teaching staff will be required to share approximately 3 hours of learning materials per day.
- To support student learning, students/parents will be able to make appointments with school staff for weekly one on one, in person learning
- Appointments can be made by calling the school 403 359 3835 or emailing a TCHS teacher.
- We will be holding class wide ZOOM connections every morning to do devotions, give instruction and touch base with students. If a student is unable to make these zoom meetings, we ask that Mr. Visser, Mrs. Bekkering or the office is made aware of this.
- Instruction will primarily be offered through instructional videos, emailed assignments and our Moodle site.
- Communication between TCHS staff and individual students will be made at least once per week (phone, ZOOM etc.)
- If coming into the school for an appointment, we require that all visitors wear a mask and to sign-in at the office. Thank-you!
