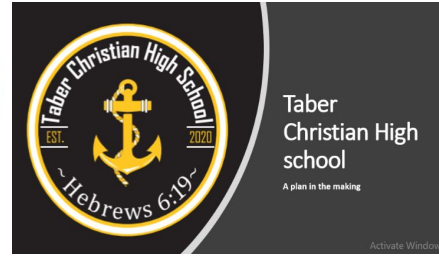

### **Alberta Provincial Education Surveys**

As in previous years, the Ministry of Education will conduct its annual satisfaction telephone/online surveys to collect public and participant perceptions of Alberta's education system. The surveys gather responses from a random sample of parents, the general public, high school students, teachers (telephone and online), principals (online) and school board trustees, as well as employers of recent high school graduates.

The purpose of the surveys is to determine satisfaction with:

- the overall quality of the education system;
- the education system meeting the needs of students and supporting our society and the economy;
- schools providing a safe, caring and inclusive environment for students etc.

The telephone/online surveys will begin on February 16, 2021 and end in June 2021. A summary of the information obtained from the surveys will be posted on the Alberta Education's website.
