September 30, 2021, will mark the first National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, a federal holiday established "to recognize and commemorate the legacy of residential schools." The Horizon School Division Board of Trustees held a special board meeting on September 7, in which they decided that Horizon would honor the 1st National Day for Truth and Reconciliation by making it non-operational for schools. While September 30 will be a non-operational day, schools will continue to engage in activities to bring this important issue to the forefront for students.
