# **PowerSchool**

TCHS is on PowerSchool - Returning students in grade 11 will be able to sign into their PowerSchool the same way as last year. New students have been set up with a login and password. Students can sign in by going to <a href="www.tchs.horizon.ab.ca">www.tchs.horizon.ab.ca</a> - go to "Quick Links" and select "PowerSchool - parents and students". Students are also able to download the PowerSchool app. They will need the code <a href="White White">NHSW</a> - that's our app jurisdiction code - to login to the app. Once they are logged in just make sure they are on Reporting Term 1 or R1 and then they should be able to see their assignments. Parents can access this information if they use the student's login and password info for now. Parents will eventually be set up with their own login and password on PowerSchool by the head office. We will let you know when this is available.
