### Emergency First Aid - CPR A & AED Training

TCHS will be offering Emergency First Aid and AED training through St. John Ambulance for our grade 10 students this year. We will be doing the blended model which allows our students to do half of the course online and half with an in person instructor from St. John Ambulance. The online portion for this will be done on **Wednesday Jan 26** and **Thursday Jan 27**. (Please note that students are expected to come into school to work on the online portion - they will do this on the school chrome books). Child first aid will be offered the morning of **Friday, Jan 28**. The in person practical portion will be done on **Monday, Jan 31** (half of the students) and **Tuesday, Feb 01** (other half of students). Students will be able to earn school credit for the training! The school will be paying for half of the cost for the course. **Students are asked to pay \$40. Information sheets were given out last week. If you need a new form, please let the office know! We ask that the bottom portion of the sheet is returned with payment to the School Office ASAP! (If students wish to NOT take this course, it needs to be indicated on the form and signed by a parent).**
