


Grade 10 - Workplace Experience Program

Mrs. Heather Brantner (Off-campus) was in this week to meet with our Grade 10 students. They started working on an online course with the students (HCS3000 - Workplace Safety Systems). This course is needed in order to do the Work Experience Program. Students will also get a credit when they complete this online course. Heather also had students login into their myPass Account.

What is myPass? MyPass is an Alberta Education self-service website for students to view progress towards high school completion. They will also use this to view diploma exam marks in the future and to order highschool transcripts. It's important for students to know that their myPass accounts are linked to their personal email addresses (not the school email). The reason for this is that school email accounts are terminated after high school completion. Students can access their myPass accounts by going to our school websites: www.tchs.horizon.ab.ca and clicking on the quicklinks>Alberta myPass. Students need to know their Alberta School Number (ASN) number for this. This number is on the top of their report cards and also shows on their PowerSchool accounts. If you have any questions, please contact the school office.
