Update!

TCHS has been looking into the possibility of going to a 4.5 day schedule (no classes on Friday afternoon) for the 2022 - 23 school year. This was first brought up at our December 6, 2021 School Council meeting where the motion passed 10 - 1.

This was then brought forward to a larger community meeting (Jan 26) where all TCS grade 8 and 9 parents as well as existing TCHS parents were invited. The meeting was chaired by Horizon superintendent Wilco Tymensen, with TCHS administration contributing points for reflection. From that point on until Monday, February 14 parents had the opportunity to submit a vote (with a paper or electronic ballot) on the proposal. 48 votes were received, with 35 votes being in favor (73%) of the proposal.

This was then taken to the Horizon School Division Board when the motion officially passed. This means that TCHS will go to a 4.5 day week starting the next school year. TCHS staff acknowledges that there was some concern expressed by parents over not having a way to get their son or daughter home at noon on Fridays. Please note that while we won't be having classes on Friday afternoons, the school will remain open at that time for students that need a place.

Our 2022 - 23 calendar will be shared in the next couple of weeks (once we have ironed out the details).

Alberta School Councils and Assurance Framework



Over the next while parents will be (or possibly already have been) notified about an assurance survey for their child(ren's) school. The purpose of the survey is to ensure accountability, engagement, transparency and reporting. We ask that parents participate in the survey as this provides feedback to our school and school division.
