Notes from the Principal:

Easter is such a powerful holiday that the entire Christian story and faith hangs on it. Jesus. The promised One hung on a cross. Philip Yancey writes the following about the death of our Savior:

“The might of the world - the most sophisticated religious system of its time allied with the most powerful political empire sets itself against a solitary figure, the only perfect man who ever lived. Though He is mocked by powers and abandoned by friends, yet the gospels give the strong ironic sense that He himself is overseeing the whole long process. He has resolutely set His face for Jerusalem knowing the fate that awaits. The cross has been His goal all along. Now as death nears, He calls the shots.” (The Jesus I Never Knew, p.188).

From here we go to the glory of the resurrection. Interestingly, the gospels don't present the resurrection with arguments designed to prove each point, but instead they reveal the shock of the disciples. “Is not death irreversible?” There was in fact a conspiracy. However, it did not come from Jesus followers, but from authorities trying to explain an empty tomb.

We, who read the gospels from the other side of Easter, forget how hard it would be for the disciples to believe. After rising, Jesus appears to many small groups make a reader wonder what it would have been like for Jesus to appear in front of bigger crowds? It would seem that wasn't the goal of Jesus. In reflecting on the rest of scripture we know that God chooses the slow and difficult way. But we also know that God is not satisfied with a sin filled planet. Diving love finds a way to overcome. We are reminded of this at Easter. We wish you a great holiday this blessed time of year.

For classes like English, Social, Biology, Physics, Math Christian Studies and CALM they continue right on as they are on a semester system. This also includes our Art, Music and Drama options. However, for our 1 credit CTS (Career and Technology Study) option courses, students will have the opportunity to select new ones.
