Grade 10 students have been set up with a myPass account through Alberta Education. This account is used for many things including



ordering high school transcripts, viewing diploma exam marks, registering to write or rewrite a diploma, viewing progress towards a credential diploma or certificate, and much more. We encourage students in grades 11 and 12 to access their myPass accounts regularly to view their progress in high school. Please note that students need to sign in to this account using a personal email (not school email) that has been given to the office and has been set-up to link to their myPass account. If students forget their email, they can ask at the office.
