As partial requirement for the Grade 9 Bible course; CALM 20 course (grade 10) and Religious Studies 25 course (grade 11), students are required to complete a total of 10 volunteer hours. What kind of activities are eligible?

- + School community service – completed outside of class time
- + Church community service
- + Fundraising – for a community group or the school
- + Sports / recreation – coaching/ refing / helping organize different events
- + Community projects – food drives, support services for community groups.
- + Community events – helping organize fairs, parades, projects etc.
- + Environmental projects – community clean up, flower / tree planting etc.
- + Volunteer work with seniors (assisting in a senior's residence, serving snacks etc.)
- + Health agencies – volunteering in hospitals / Letters of Hope
- + Kids program – helping out with community children's programs
- + Work with animals – assisting with animal care



What makes an activity ineligible?

- + Student receives payment for service
- + Student receives school credit for work
- + Provides direct financial benefit or gain to the student or student's family (e.g. payment, reduced fees, or discount)
- + Occurs during the school day or as a class requirement (note – volunteering done during a spare is acceptable).



Note: grade 9 students can complete 5 of these hours in helping out their family.
