- All exams begin at 9am. We require students to be here at regular class start time (8:35) in order to do devotions and go over instructions. Please be on time!
- Grades 10-12 have regular classes until Wednesday, January 17 with the exception of the grade 12 diploma on Wednesday, January 10. Exams begin on the 18th. After exams are completed, students are able to go home. If there is no exam scheduled for a student, then they do NOT have to be at school on this day.
- Grade 9s do not have final exams until June. Instead, they will be having midterms. You will see
 that they have regular classes up until the 19th. Monday, Jan 22, grades 9s have two midterms
 in the morning and then will go to the Civic center and pool in the afternoon to participate in the
 Cardboard boat races! There are also Grade 9 midterms on Jan 24 and 26. Students are able to
 go home as soon as these midterms are finished.
- Regular bussing will continue throughout exams. Students are able to stay come to school when
 they do not have a scheduled exam if they wish to study. Students are also able to stay at TCHS
 after their exam is finished if they need to take the bus home at the end of the day.

Grade 10s will have the opportunity to sign up for First Aid Training with St. John Ambulance in January. It involved online training (January 26) and in person training with a St. John Ambulance instructor (January 29). Students will receive 2 course credits for this course as well. We have 18 spots available. It is an optional course but strongly recommended as an easy way to get 2 credits! An additional cost of \$50 will be required per student to help cover the costs of the course. More information to come out in January.
