Grade 9 year-end class trip!

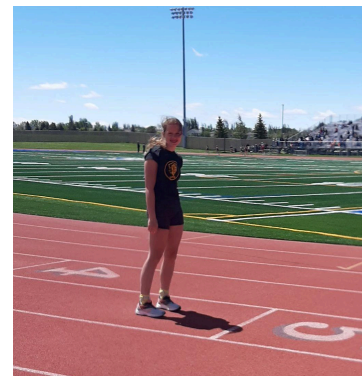
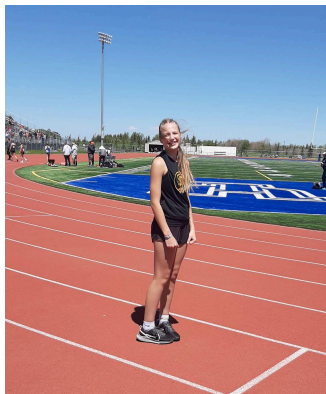
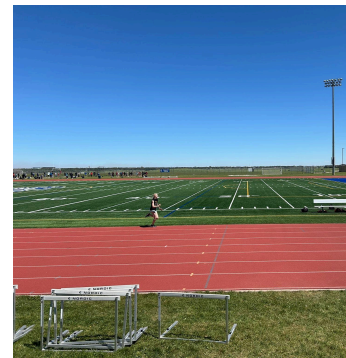
