Terry Fox Run

On September 26, 2024, staff and students at TCHS participated in our annual Terry Fox Run. Terry Fox began his Marathon of Hope in 1980 to help others who were suffering from cancer by raising funds for cancer research. Terry was determined to run across Canada, despite having a prosthetic on one leg. Through all types of bad weather and terrain, he managed to run 42 kilometers a day for 143 days. Terry had to stop running when his cancer came back, but his efforts are still inspiring us and changing the world four decades later.

Unfortunately, we all probably know someone with cancer or have been touched by cancer in some way. This event was an opportunity for TCHS staff and students to show how much we care and to make a difference in the lives of those fighting cancer. Over the past week, staff and students have been collecting donations towards the Terry Fox Foundation. The Terry Fox Foundation gives the money to the Terry Fox Research Institute to help scientists and researchers all across Canada develop new and better treatments for cancer patients. Donations will continue to be collected until Wednesday October 2, 2024.
