- All exams begin at 9am. We require students to be here at regular class start time (8:35) for devotions and announcements. Please be on time!
- Grades 10-12 have regular classes until Thursday January 16 with the exception of the grade 12 diploma on Tuesday, January 14. Exams begin on the 20th. After exams are completed, students are able to go home. If there is no exam scheduled for a student, then they do NOT have to be at school on this day.
- Grade 9s do not have final exams until June. Instead, they will be having midterms. They will write their midterms in the morning and then proceed to have regular classes. Friday, Jan 17, Gr. 9 students will write their math midterm and are free to leave after this is done - no regular classes after! There is no school for Grade 9 students from January 20-27.
- Regular bussing will continue throughout exams. Students are able to stay come to school when they do not have a scheduled exam if they wish to study. Students are also able to stay at TCHS after their exam is finished if they need to take the bus home at the end of the day.
- Grade 10s will have the opportunity to sign up for First Aid Training with St. John Ambulance in January. It involved online training (January 24 or prior) and in person training with a St. John Ambulance instructor (January 27 and 28). Students will receive 2 course credits for this course as well. We have 18 spots available each day. It is an optional course but strongly recommended as an easy way to get 2 credits!
