## Alberta myPass Accounts!

Grade 10 students are talking about MyPass accounts as part of their CALM class right now.

"myPass" is an education account that students are able to use to access important information such as their detailed academic reports, diploma exam marks, transcripts and more. We encourage students to regularly sign into their myPass account for credit checks to make sure they are staying on track for graduation requirements. Student myPass accounts have been set up with the student's personal email rather than their school email. \*\* If you are a grade 11 or 12 student that is unable to sign into their account, please visit the office for some assistance!

## "I Wish The Youth in my Life Knew Survey"

The Family School Liaison Program is working on a project to gather insight into current student needs and mental health wellness. To do this, the Wellness Coach, Hailey Astalos, created a Google form for students to submit feedback on what they wish adults knew about their lives. Students responded to the prompts and Hailey gathered the information and posted it on a bulletin board across from the office. This survey for parents/adults has been created by your school's mental health and wellness team (Rylee Beland and Hailey Astalos). Adults are asked to view the Bulletin Board before responding to this survey or check out the picture beside this post. After doing so, take time to reflect on what you may say to one of those students (a response that resonated with you), your own child when they are struggling, or to your younger self.
