Track and Field is quickly wrapping up again this season! We had our Grade 9 Horizon Track meet this past week. From TCHS, we only had two athletes participate - Jack Delaney and Alvin Friesen who both went into the Javelin and long jump events - placing 4th and 5th! Our Sr. High Zones was held at the University of Lethbridge yesterday. Brodie Delaney ran the 1500, Shandeah Stickel was in shot put, discus and long jump. Chloe Vanderwekken ran the 3000m, placing 1st and the 1500 placing 1st as well! Iya Hoekstra threw javelin and placed 1st. Iya set a new record of 34.70 metres - Two metres further than the last record in 2014! Both Iya and Chloe qualify for provincials which will be held in Calgary on June 06! Thanks to Mrs. Ohlmann and Mr. Visser for coaching our track and field athletes this season!

- All exams begin at 9am. We require students to be here at regular class start time (8:35) in order to do devotions and go over instructions. Please be on time!
- Grades 10-12 have regular classes until Friday, June 13 with the exception of the grade 12 diploma on Thursday, June 12. After exams are completed, students are able to go home. If there is no exam scheduled for a student, then they do NOT have to be at school on this day.
- Grade 9s have PATS in English, Math, Science and Social. You will notice that the Math and English PATS are in two parts. After they write their PAT, they are expected to stay at school as they will have regular classes for the rest of the day. We will be planning an activity for the grade 9s on Thursday, June 19 in the afternoon as this is their last day of school.
- Regular bussing will continue throughout exams. Students are able to stay come to school when they do not have a scheduled exam if they wish to study. Students are also able to stay at TCHS after their exam is finished if they need to take the bus home at the end of the day.

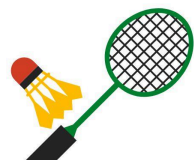
# **TCHS ATHLETICS AWARDS & DESSERT NIGHT 2025!**
