*Grade 11 students are also able to take this block as a spare, however are recommended to sign up for a class here if there is already a spare in your schedule. Please note that Sociology 30 and PE 20 are not required courses.
*Grade 12 students do not need to sign up for either of these courses but are recommended to sign up for one if there is a need for more credits - please consult with the office if needed!

Grade 12 students will also see that they are in "Career & Vocation / Passion Projects" in Block 2 of the first semester. This course will be taught by Ms. Svrta and is a graduation requirement for TCHS students. The course will have minimal classroom instruction but does require more independent work.
